## COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS

### EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM | \$1,233,930 IN FUNDING

Ensured that the needs of hungry and homeless people are met by serving as the secretariat for the Emergency Food and Shelter Program. \$1,233,930 in funding was provided from Oct. 2016 to Jan. 2018.

### PROJECT REACH | \$500,000 IN ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Provided financial assistance to qualified customers who experience unplanned hardships and are unable to pay for their electricity needs in 2017-18.

### WORKPLACE CAMPAIGN | \$7.1 MILLION RAISED

Raised \$7.1M for local nonprofits and schools in 2016-17 through workplace campaigns at hundreds of companies.

### CRISIS FUNDS | \$85,863 DISTRIBUTED

Managed funds at local workplace campaigns in 2016-17 to help employees in times of crisis.

### COMMUNITY INVESTMENT ACCOUNT FUNDS | \$463,402 DISTRIBUTED

Managed a unique annual plan for charitable giving in 2016-17 by distributing donations to selected nonprofits.
