Since the inception of the Emergency Assistance and Community Needs Fund in March 2020, UWSN has deployed \$2.3 million dollars to 34 local organizations providing support to individuals and families affected by COVID-19 in Southern Nevada.

As of June 30, 2020, \$1.3M in EACN funds were spent toward assistance for community members in need:
