UWSN focuses efforts in Clark County high schools and neighborhoods where graduation rates are below average



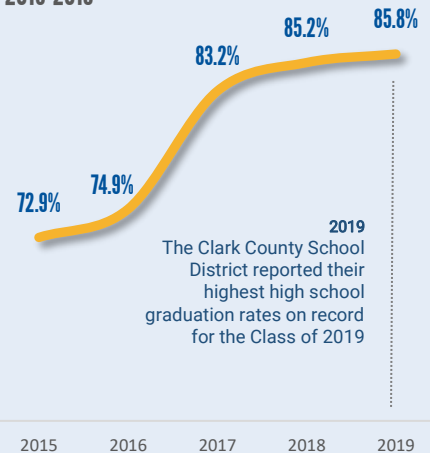
Programs funded by UWSN provide tutoring, homework assistance, healthy behaviors, and health care services

## UNITED WAY GAVE JEREMY A STRONG FOUNDATION

Jeremy, a sixth grader, started the school year by hardly ever speaking or participating in class. After spending time with teachers at his local library, his teachers and tutors started noticing subtle differences in his behavior.

After showing up for tutoring four days a week, Jeremy started becoming more involved in class and his grades improved over the year. Now in seventh grade, he plans to continue participating, both during and after school.

### GRADUATION RATES CONTINUE TO RISE

Since 2015, United Way of Southern Nevada has supported thousands of middle and high school students.

Over the same period, high school graduation rates increased from 72.9% to 85.8%, representing an increase of more than 13 percentage points, or nearly 5,000 additional high school graduates each year.

## CCSD HS GRADUATION RATES (GRADUATING CLASS OF 2019)

Southern Nevada has experienced incredible improvement in the high school graduation rate, but there is still progress to make.

Male students, Hispanic students, Black students, English language learners, lower-income students, and those on individual education plans graduate at rates below the Clark County School District average.

### Graduation Rate by Race & Ethnicity



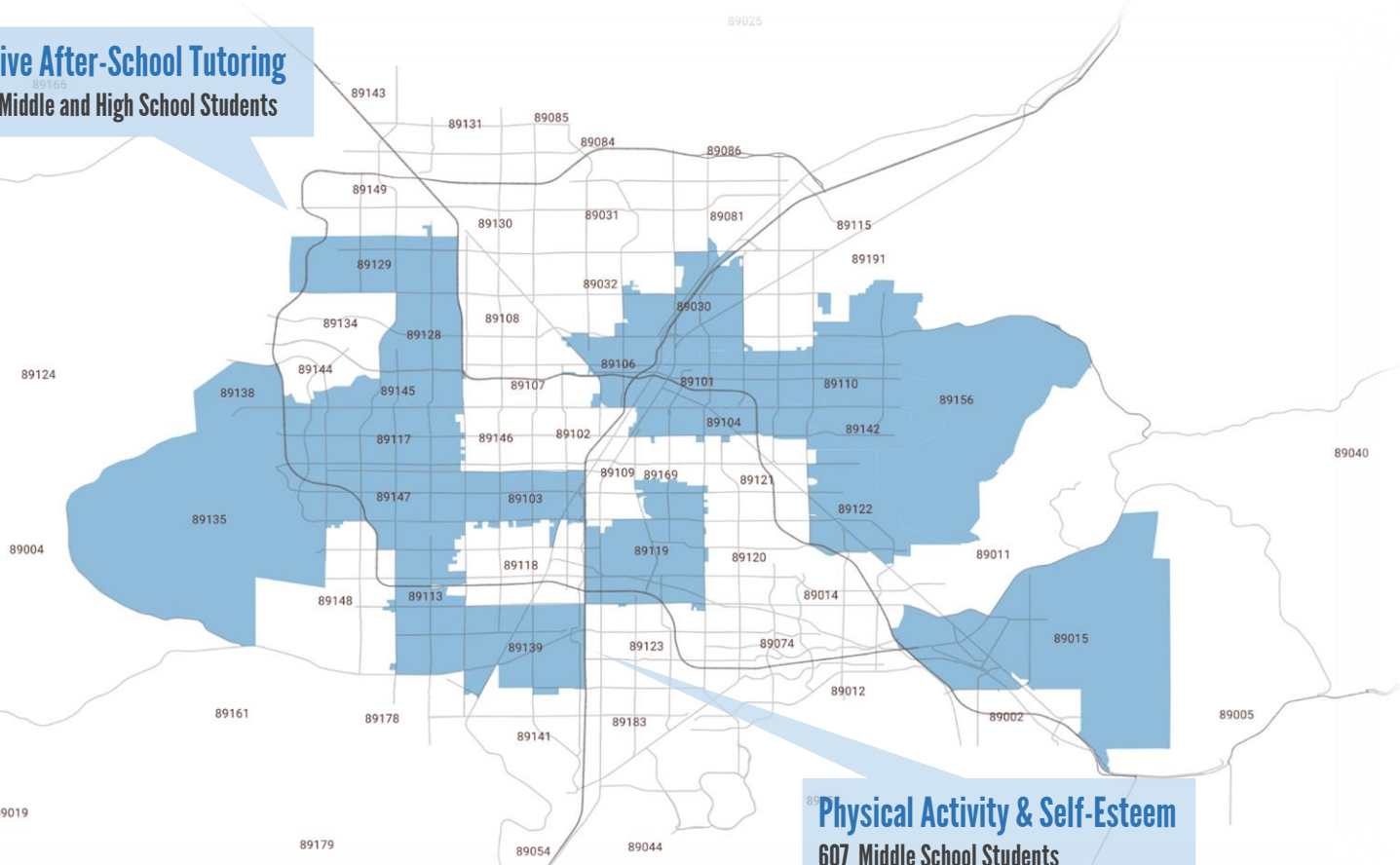
### Graduation Rate by Special Group
