Our goal is to increase the proportion of families with full-time employment and the skills needed to meet the demands of the present and future economy.

Over the last two years, donations from people like you helped United Way grant over \$355,000 to support more than 10,600 workers with job readiness training, mobile health services, internships, and career planning programs.

Over 2,000 working families were supported with child care assistance or health services, and more than 4,300 job seekers found employment


UWSN HELPS FAMILIES PREPARE FOR SUCCESS


